Audition Requirements:

1. Repertoire

Strings: a short piece

Woodwind: 2 contrasting pieces or studies

Brass: 2 contrasting pieces or studies

Mozart - "Dies Irae" from Requiem. (mm. 1-9)

Rachmaninoff, Symphony No. 2, second movement. (19 measures after

 (3 octaves, sixteenth notes, 60 bpm, four-note slurs)
- Viola: E major, F melodic minor
 (3 octaves, sixteenth notes, 60 bpm, four-note slurs)
- Cello: E major, G melodic minor
 (3 octaves, sixteenth notes, 60 bpm, four-note slurs)
- Double Bass: Bb major, C melodic minor
 (2 octaves, eighth notes, 60 bpm, two-note slurs)
- Woodwind: Chromatic scale in A, D major, G melodic minor
 (2 octaves, eighth notes, 60 bpm, four-notes slurs)
- Brass: F major, Bb melodic minor
 (1 octave, eighth notes, 60 bpm, two-notes slurs)
- Percussion: Glockenspiel on G Major, F Major, C Minor, D Minor
